The practical usage of video conferencing platforms for online classes such as Zoom, Google Meet, Teachmint, Microsoft Team as well as learning management systems like Moodle, Blackboard etc. have been encouraged to support students' learning in all possible manner during lockdown. YouTube, E-mails, WhatsApp group, Telegram Group are used as platforms to communicate, provide material and syllabus, make announcements, conduct tests, upload assignments, make presentations, address queries, mentor and share information. Google classroom is used to manage and post course related information learning material, quizzes, lab submissions and evaluations, assignments etc.</p> <p>Virtual labs are used to conduct labs through simulations. Faculties prepare online quiz for students after the completion of each unit with the help of Google forms. Recording of video lectures is made available to students for long term learning and future referencing.</p> <p>Now days, it is essential for the students to learn and master the latest technologies in order to be corporate ready. As a consequence, teachers are combining technology with traditional mode of instruction to engage students in long term learning. The teachers use online education resources, social networking sites and blended learning platforms to effectively deliver teaching and provide enhanced learning experience to the students. Teachers prepared modules on important topics, which are produced, recorded and made available for students online. All teachers of the college are using ICT tools and resources available in campuses. Faculties are using ICT in education to support, enhance and optimize the delivery of education, so that students learning can be strengthened and made effective.</p>
