A) IMPORTANCE OF HISTORY:

History is one of the important subjects in arts faculty. It is defined as 'A continual communication between the past and present'. It means that history is not related just with the past, but it has a connection with the present and future also. It decides the undercurrents of the present society. Prof. Alton in his book 'The Practice of History' states, 'Historical knowledge gives solidity to the understanding of the present and may suggest guiding lines for the future'.

Moreover, history gives rational attitude and increases reasoning power. R.G. Collingwood in his book, 'Idea of History' speaks of the scope of history in the following words, 'History has a value, its teachings are useful for human life, simply because the rhythm of its change is likely to repeat itself. Similar antecedents leading to similar consequents,' the history of notable events is worth remembering in order to serve as a basis for prognostic, judgments not demonstrable but probable laying down not what will happen, but what is likely to happen, indicating the paints of danger in rhythms now going on.
